To all St. Brendan Students, Faculty, Alumni, & Friends:

I hope this message finds everyone well and off to a great new school year.

In January 2005, after a year of serving on the Board of the Father Dennehy Memorial Fund, I was elected to serve as President of the Fund. I am honored to serve in this capacity for an Institution that afforded me so many special experiences. The Father Dennehy Memorial Fund (FDMF), named after St. Brendan's founding Principal Father Thomas Dennehy, is operated by an independent Board of Directors comprised of Alumni from each decade of the school's existence as well as some dedicated Faculty members currently teaching at St. Brendan. Our sole purpose is to raise funds from Sabre Alumni and Friends to help support any current St. Brendan student in urgent need. When a student and their family are met with the prospect of having to leave the school because of a family situation that affects their financial ability to afford tuition, we step in on an anonymous basis to subsidize the student's level of need.

In 2004, thanks to the efforts of our Board and Supporters, we raised a record amount of over \$9,000 and are currently sponsoring two excellent students. Some of our past sponsored students have gone on to excel at the University level. Looking forward, we want to expand our efforts to assist our FDMF sponsored graduates with college scholarships. In order to do this and to continue to raise the funds needed to support the FDMF, we realized that St. Brendan needed an Alumni Association. The FDMF Board decided to take action and with the support of the administration, we have formed the first official St. Brendan High Alumni Association (SBHAA). The FDMF will now be a subset of the SBHAA. St. Brendan boasts one of the highest Alumni Faculty ratios in all of Dade County. About 1/3 of our teachers are Alumni, it is truly a beautiful legacy of SBHS.

The timing of launching the Alumni Association could not be better. St. Brendan is set to celebrate its 30th Anniversary in 2005-2006. What better way to celebrate our Sabre legacy than to invite everyone back to campus and to get involved in the Alumni Association. In this newsletter you will find more information on becoming a member of the Association, a unique opportunity to be recognized as a Founding Member, supporting the FDMF, and a listing of special events for everyone to come back to campus to commemorate the 30th Anniversary and launch of the St. Brendan High Alumni Association.

As you can see, these are exciting times at St. Brendan, but we need your help. I want to extend to all of you an invitation to get involved with the Alumni Association and in the 30th Anniversary Celebration. **Spiritual Corner**

How do you feel when you're complimented? Embarrassed? This typical reaction happens because we fail to realize that it is God our Father who is praising us. In a Gospel passage, Jesus makes it clear that the only praise that really matters is that which originates from the Father, and such praise is very important.

Praise is good. We were made in the image of a God who values being praised. But because we're afraid that it's not humble to accept compliments, we quickly negate the affirmation. Well guess what. That's telling the people who compliment us that they're liars. And it initiates the game of "If I say I'm not worthy of your praise, then you'll try to convince me that I am indeed worthy of it, and I'll get more attention from you as we drag this out longer."

What a mess! Pride gets confused with humility. True humility means accepting praise and acknowledging that ultimately the credit goes to God. True humility means affirming those who compliment us by accepting their kind words and good intentions.

Jesus said that the Father's praise gives testimony about the Son's worth. Jesus was NOT implying that John's affirmation was invalid. On the contrary, he reminded the Jews about John's testimony precisely because it was very important indeed. But greater than John's praise was the Father's. The one who sent Jesus into the world was the best one to judge how well he was fulfilling his calling.

You, too, have been sent by the Father. You, too, have been commissioned and empowered to give Jesus to the world by using all of the gifts he has given you, i.e., all the good that is in you. If you're doing this to the best of your current ability, and if you're obeying the Father to the best of your awareness, repenting when you slip into sin, the Father is praising you as much as he praised his Son, Jesus.
