To all St. Brendan Students, Faculty, Alumni, & Friends:

I hope this message finds everyone well and off to a great 2006!

In January 2005, after a year of serving on the Board of the Father Dennehy Memorial Fund, I was elected to serve as President of the Fund. I am honored to serve in this capacity for an Institution that afforded me so many special experiences. The Father Dennehy Memorial Fund (FDMF), named after St. Brendan's founding Principal Father Thomas Dennehy, is operated by an independent Board of Directors comprised of Alumni from each decade of the school's existence as well as some dedicated Faculty members currently teaching at St. Brendan. Our sole purpose is to raise funds from Sabre Alumni and Friends to help support any current St. Brendan student in urgent need. When a student and their family are met with the prospect of having to leave the school because of a family situation that affects their financial ability to afford tuition, we step in on an anonymous basis to subsidize the student's level of need.

Since 1998, the fund has raised over \$20,000 and sponsored 10 students who have all gone on to graduate. We are currently supporting three students attending St. Brendan. In order to meet this commitment and continue to raise the funds needed to support the FDMF, we realized that St. Brendan needed an Alumni Association. The FDMF Board decided to take action and with the support of the administration, we formed the first official St. Brendan High Alumni Association (SBHAA). The FDMF will now be a subset of the SBHAA. St. Brendan boasts one of the highest Alumni Faculty ratios in all of Dade County. About 1/3 of our teachers are Alumni, it is truly a beautiful legacy of SBHS and we intend to carry the alumni tradition forward. In this newsletter you will find information on how to contribute to thefund, join the Alumni Association, and get more involved with St. Brendan.

The launch of the Association could not have better timing as 2005-06 marks the 30th Anniversary of our alma mater. Several events have commemorated both milestones. In April 2005, we held the successful kickoff cocktail on campus; the 30th Anniversary Gala at the JW Marriott was held in November where we honored Bert & Esther Jordan with our Distinguished Alumni Award; and a new tradition was born when alumni were invited back to campus for the first ever Homecoming Alumni Tailgate, held before the Friday night Girls & Boys Homecoming Basketball games in January. Upcoming events include Sabre Success Career Days and the presentation of the Alumni Founders plaque that will commemorate those who joined as founding members in this first year of the Alumni Association. The plaque will hang at the entrance of the school.

As you can see, these are exciting times at St. Brendan, but we need your help. I want to extend to all of you an invitation to get involved with the Alumni Association and in the 30th Anniversary Celebration. For more information please go to our website at www.stbrendanalumni.org.

During the evening, Brother Felix (Principle), Father Heria (Supervising Principle), Bertha Alvarez (Director of Development), & Javi Borges (President of Alumni Association) presented the Father Dennehy Distinguished Alumni Award to two very special alumni. The honorees are selected not only for their professional achievements but also for demonstrating Christian principles in their everyday lives and for service to their community and their alma mater.


